

Collection of 24-hour urine sample for Urinary 5HIAA

Patient Information Sheet

You may find it convenient to collect the urine over a weekend to avoid having to take the container to work with you.

If you require further specimen containers please email **LSC@tdlpathology.com** or call **020 7307 7373** who will be able to assist you. Please return the sample with the Request Form. Read through all of the instructions below before taking your sample.

- 1 Do not collect the first urine sample of the day. For example, go to the toilet as normal.
- 2 Collect the second urination of the day and all urine samples for the next 24 hours in the container provided. For example: from **08:00AM** to **08:00AM** the next day.
- **3** Please label the container with the following: Patient name, DOB, Date of sample, Sex, Date and time of collection and Volume.
- 4 Store container in a cool place, preferably a refrigerator.
- **5** Keep the container upright during collection.
- 6 Place the container in the specimen bag provided.
- 7 Please return the sample with the request form to the Laboratory.

If you are on any medication please give the Phlebotomist/Receptionist/Laboratory full details when you return your sample.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

For 3 days prior to and during the collection you must avoid the following:


Avocado
Citrus fruit
Pineapple
Eggplant/Aubergine
Plums
Walnuts
Alcohol
Caffeine (including tea and coffee)
Gooseberries
Bananas
Chocolate
Walnuts
Alcohol
Kiwi fruit

Melons
 Red currants
 All fruit juices

In addition, please abstain from the following medications:

Acetaminophen
Iodine solutions
Muscle relaxants
Antidepressants
Paracetamol

Salicylate
 MAO inhibitors methocarbamol, mephenesin, guaifenesin
